TappCar: A ridesharing app like Uber, but not Uber, but basically Uber **Cabs:** Unicity Taxi (204.925.3131), Duffy's Taxi (204.925.0101), Spring Taxi (204.774.8294)

Winnipeg Transit: Simply provide Google Maps with your whereabouts and where you wish to be. You will then be given transit bus number options. Bus fare is \$2.95. Winnipeg also has the handy-dandy Downtown Spirit, which has 3 bus routes free of charge to get you all around the downtown area.

Spirit routes 1 & 2: 11am-3:30pm on weekdays & 11am-5:30pm on weekends.

Spirit route 3: 7am-7pm on weekdays & 11am-7pm on weekends *** Route 3 can take you to and from Oseredok

Walking: The Alt Hotel is approx. 15 minutes from Oseredok, 20 minutes from The Forks and under 20 minutes to many other downtown places to visit.
